Are You Election Ready?

New voter registrations and all party affiliation changes must be received by **February 16, 2016**. Register to vote at the Elections Office, Driver's License Offices, HRS Centers and State Offices which serve persons with disabilities. Florida Voter Registration Applications may be picked up at Driver's License Offices and all Public Libraries, City Halls and Post Offices. You may also download an application online at www.FlaglerElections.com

Have You Moved?

Vote By Mail.

Any registered and qualified voter in Flagler County may vote by mail ballot. You may request a mail ballot in person, by mail, online or by telephone. You must provide your name, address, date of birth, address to which ballot is to be mailed (and signature, if a written request). Mail ballot request deadline is **March 9, 2016**.

Vote Early.

Early voting for this election begins 10 days prior to Election Day and ends the Saturday before Election Day. Any registered and eligible voter in the county may vote early according to this schedule:

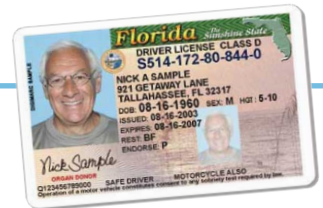

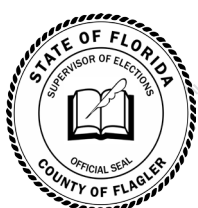


Show Your ID.

Florida Law requires each voter to present both photo **and** signature identification at the polls:

- Florida Driver's License
- Florida ID card (issued by DHSMV)
- U.S. Passport
- Debit or Credit Card
- Military ID or Student ID
- Retirement Center or Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID

Expired ID's will not be accepted.
