PRIMARY ELECTION DAY: AUGUST 28, 2018



FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE



If you wish to vote for a partisan candidate in a Primary Election you must be a registered voter in the party for which the Primary is being held. All registered voters, regardless of party affiliation, can vote on issues and nonpartisan candidates in a Primary Election. Party change deadline for the upcoming Primary Election is July 30, 2018. **Some nonpartisan races may be decided in this election. Remember to vote!**

Please note all Palm Coast city voters, regardless of party affiliation, are eligible to cast a vote for city offices during this election.

Attention Palm Coast Voters:

Candidate qualifying ends June 22 at Noon. The following offices may be on the ballot for all voters who reside within the City of Palm Coast:

- CITY COUNCIL MEMBER, DISTRICT 2
- CITY COUNCIL MEMBER, DISTRICT 4

REGISTRATION BOOKS CLOSING

The deadline for citizens who are not registered to vote or who wish to change their party affiliation is July 30, 2018.

VOTE BY MAIL INFORMATION

Any registered and qualified voter in Flagler County may choose to vote by mail. You may request a mail ballot in person, by mail, fax, online or by telephone. You must provide your name, address, date of birth, address to which ballot is to be mailed (and signature, if a written request). Mail ballot request deadline is **August 22, 2018**.

CANVASSING BOARD

The Flagler County Canvassing Board will convene at the office of the Flagler County Supervisor of Elections, 1769 E. Moody Blvd., Bldg. 2, Ste. 101, Bunnell, Florida for the testing of ballot tabulating equipment and canvassing of ballots. In accordance with the Sunshine Law, these meetings will be open to the public.
