“Are you election ready? The deadline for new voter registrations for citizens who reside within the city limits of Bunnell or Flagler Beach is Monday, February 6, 2017. A municipal election is scheduled for The City of Bunnell and the City of Flagler Beach on March 7, 2017.”

Bunnell, FL – Two city commissioners are up for election in both Flagler Beach and Bunnell. The election will be held on March 7, 2017. Anyone who resides within the city limits and is not registered to vote must register by February 6, 2017 to be eligible to vote in this election.

REGISTER TO VOTE:

You may register to vote in person at the Elections Office, driver's license offices, public libraries, HRS centers and state offices that serve persons with disabilities. You may also register by mail. Mail registration applications are available at post offices, schools, libraries, city halls, or community centers, as well as many businesses throughout the county. You may also call the Flagler County Elections Office at (386) 313-4170 to have an application mailed to you or you may complete and print the Florida Voter Registration Application.
