MAR 17	Presidential Preference Primary MARCH 17, 2020 Voter registration and party change deadline: FEBRUARY 18, 2020
AUG 18	Primary Election AUGUST 18, 2020 Voter registration and party change deadline: JULY 20, 2020
NOV 3	General Election NOVEMBER 3, 2020 Voter registration and party change deadline: OCTOBER 5, 2020
